DPSG

- established in 1980
- 6'000 students
- co-educational
- private school
- junior (up to cl.), secondary (cl. 6- 10) and senior school (cl. 11/12)
- academic ambition/record: one of the best schools in Delhi-NCR/in India

KSM

- established in 2002
- 360 students
- co-educational
- state school
- secondary school I and II (cl. 7 -12)
- academic ambition/record: preparing all the students for university

DPSG

- average class size: 40 students
- city wide transportation services
- classrooms: smart class-enabled
- premises: 61'000 m², modern facilities
- importance of school events

KSM

- average class size: 18 students
- public transport (ZVB)
- classrooms: smart class-enabled
- premises: much smaller, modern facilities
- importance of school events
