Use **WOW** words !!!

These are high-level words which make your English sound even better.

good → **great, wonderful, fantastic, fabulous, ...**

to go → **to walk, run, stroll, jog, dash, sprint, ...**

a house → **a mansion, building, cottage, residence, ...**

How to find **WOW** words

- Think!
- Ask other people!
- Look for synonyms (=words with the same meaning)
in a thesaurus or on <http://www.powerthesaurus.org>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Write down 4 true or false statements about the audio (= sentences which can be true or not)• Read them out to your classmates.• Let them correct the false statements.	 2

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Find three good titles for the audio.• Have your classmates vote for the best one.	 3
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Draw a rough picture about the audio but include a few mistakes.• Show your picture to your classmates and have them find the mistakes.	 4

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Write down at least 3 questions about the text.• Let your classmates answer them.	 1
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Write down 4 true or false statements for the text (= sentences which can be true or not).• Read them out to your classmates.• Let them correct the false statements.	 2

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rewrite the text, using as many wow words as possible. Think about what you can see, hear, smell and feel. • How many wow words can you add? 	 <p>3</p>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Practise reading the text out loud, but replacing some words with any other words you think would also fit. <i>Example: instead of reading “The big bad wolf ..” you read “The big bad penguin” or “the big bad pig...”</i> • Then read it out to your classmates and they should shout "Beep" as soon as they hear a word that you have changed. They are not allowed to follow the text in the book. 	 <p>4</p>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Include at least one adjective in every sentence you say.	 1
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Include some sentences which are not true when you speak.• Have your partners react when you say something wrong.	 2

	<p><i>Chant, rhyme or song:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Change it into a rap or create a completely new rap.• Present it to the class.	 3
	<p><i>Roleplay:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Perform a “one person role-play” using for example pens as puppets and have them have a conversation.	 4

	<p><i>When copying or writing down words:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Add to each of them a wow word <i>Example: a noise -> a terrifying noise</i>	 1
	<p><i>When copying or writing down words:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use as many of the given words as possible in one single sentence.• Give your text to a classmate who must then underline all the words from the unit.	 2

	<p><i>When writing texts:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Include at least one adjective in each of your sentences. • Revise your text, then give it to your teacher or a parent to correct. 	 <p>3</p>
	<p><i>When writing texts:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Include as many wow words as possible in your writing. • Revise your text, underlining all the wow words in red and add some more, then give it to your teacher or a parent to correct. 	 <p>4</p>
