These are high-level words which make your English sound even better.

good → **great, wonderful, fantastic, fabulous, ...**

to go → **to walk, run, stroll, jog, dash, sprint, ...**

a house → **a mansion, building, cottage, residence, ...**

How to find **WOW** words

- Think!
- Ask other people!
- Look for synonyms (=words with the same meaning) in a thesaurus or on <http://www.powerthesaurus.org>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Write down at least 4 true or false statements.• Put your statements under the visualizer and let your classmates write down the answers.• Discuss the answers with the class.	 2

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Try to mime some actions that are talked about in the text.• Let your classmates guess which scenes you are showing.	 3
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Write down 5 nouns (<i>Nomen</i>) from the text.• Add to each one an adjective to make the text more interesting. <i>Example: house → an <u>enormous</u> house</i>• Then read out the text with your added adjectives.	 4

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Include at least one adjective in each of your sentences.	 1
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Include some sentences which are not true in the speaking activity.• Have your classmates react when you say something wrong.	 2

	<p><i>When writing down single words:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Either write a synonym (=word with the same meaning) next to it or add a wow word, for example: <i>a house → a building</i> or: <i>a house → an enormous house</i> <p>Use a thesaurus or check on http://www.powerthesaurus.org</p>	 1
	<p><i>When writing texts:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Include at least one adjective in each of your sentences.	 2
