

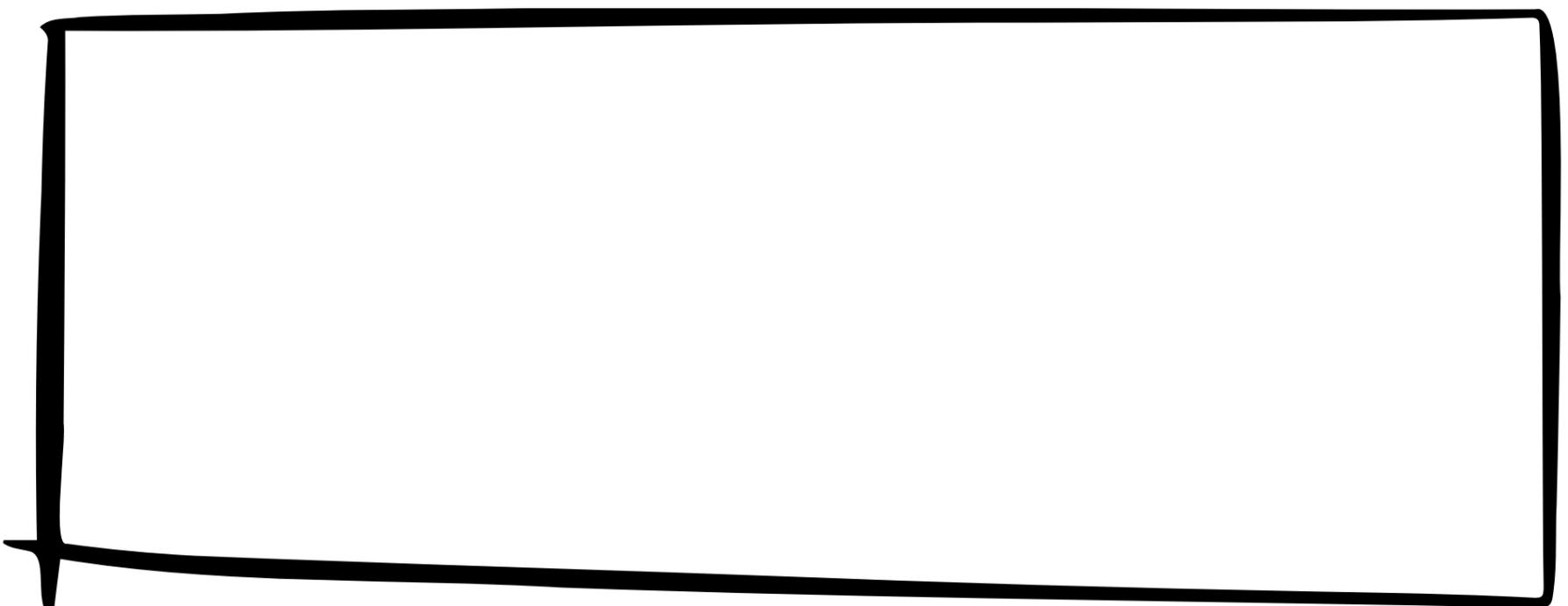
Your adventure inside the book

What belongs in a story?



Beginning:

- It should have a gripping/thrilling beginning.
- It should excite the reader and make them want to read more.

Ways to start your story:

- Once upon a time..
- One day...
- In the beginning...

Middle:

- It should include one or more interesting incident(s)
- It should include lots of details and descriptions.

Tips for the middle of your story:

- Is there a problem the main character needs to solve?
- Is there a plot twist?
- Have you included descriptions of where the characters are?

End:

- It should have a clear ending.

Tips for the end of your story:

- Is there a happy end?
- Is there a sad end?
- Is there an open end? (Is what happens at the end left open for the reader to guess)

After finishing writing, check these points:



Have you checked your **spelling**?

Are your **verbs** in the right tense?

Have you used **wow words**?
(spooky, fantastic, cold, exciting...)

Are all the right words **capitalized**?
(beginning of sentences, names,
places...)

Does your story make **sense**, without
any disturbing jumps?
