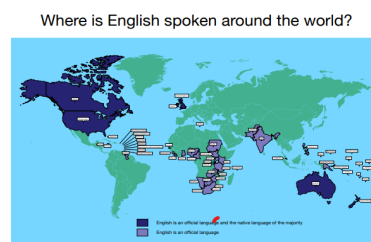
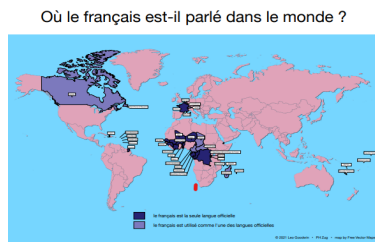


English and French speaking countries

Express Games



Game 1

- Choose one of the maps (English or French speaking countries)
- Work in pairs: A looks at the map and names a country. B immediately says which language is spoken in this country
- Change roles until each has named 5 countries
- 1 point for each correct answer

Game 2

- Make groups of 2, 3 or 4.
- Choose one of the two maps.
- Look at the chosen map and find 5 islands where EN or FR is spoken (depending on the map)
You have 3 minutes to find them and write them down. If you find more, you get extra points!
- Score 1 point per correct answer.

Game 3

- Work in pairs with both maps.
- Find two countries where EN & FR are both official languages.
- Can you find neighboring countries where EN & FR are spoken?
- Remix the groups and share your answers with your new partner.

Game 4

- Play against yourself!
- Guess on how many continents French or English is spoken. Write your guess on a piece of paper.
- Now, look at the maps and count. Did you guess well?
- Share your results with a partner.

Game 5

- Focus on Africa: name 5 African countries where French/English is spoken.
- Look up in a dictionary / online the French/English names of these countries and write them down.
- Share your results with a partner in the target language: *“On parle français au Cameroun” / English is spoken in Nigeria.*

Game 6

- Print a simple world map of the continents ([example](#)) but without country names.
- Print a list of labels with 10 countries where French and/or English is spoken.
- Make groups of 4.
- Each group cuts out the labels.
- Let's play: the map is placed on the table and the labels in a pile. Each player picks a label and places it on the right continent. Other players check the answer on the map.
- Score 1 point per correct answer.
