<b>Accommodation</b>	<p>PH Zug is usually able to place visiting students in a furnished single room with a sink, Wifi and shared bathroom and kitchen, within walking distance from the campus. The monthly rent comes to CHF 450 (approx. EUR 420). This has proven to be a very popular and convenient arrangement. The International Office PH Zug further supports students with information to find accommodation either in shared flats or in private houses. A monthly rent between CHF 600/~550€ and CHF 900/~800€ is to be calculated as an average.</p>
<b>Health Insurance</b>	<p>For international students coming to Switzerland, it is compulsory to have appropriate health insurance.
